Your electricity usage on Free Pass Days is determined from interval data from your advanced meter (Interval Data) and is also provided by the TDU. If the Billed Usage and Interval Data do not match: 1) any missing intervals in the Interval Data will first be determined using market information for your usage profile, then these intervals will be proportionately adjusted so the sum of all intervals equal the Billed Usage provided by the TDU; or 2) if there is no missing interval information, each interval of the Interval Data will be proportionately adjusted so the sum of all intervals equal the Billed Usage provided by the TDU.</p>
